

# SETUP WIZARD – FIRST MAN IN RULE

1. The “First Man In Rule” states that a door auto unlock will NOT be initiated unless a specific cardholder is present.
2. To build the “First Man In Rule,” it must be enabled, and a valid cardholder with a card must be present.

# SETUP WIZARD – MANAGER IN RULE

1. The “Manager In Rule” states that no cardholders are allowed access unless a defined manager is present.
2. To build the “Manager In Rule,” it must be enabled.
3. Select “Schedule” for “Manager In Rule” and select “Door Manager” from the cardholder list.

# SETUP WIZARD – TWO MAN IN RULE

1. The "Two Man In Rule" states that two separate cardholders must present their cards in a defined period of time in a defined order in order to gain access to any given door.
2. To build the "Two Man In Rule" it must be enabled and the "Time Frame" must be selected.
3. Click on the search icon to view a list of cardholders. Select Cardholder 1 and use the arrow to move. Repeat for Cardholder 2 and select "Save."
